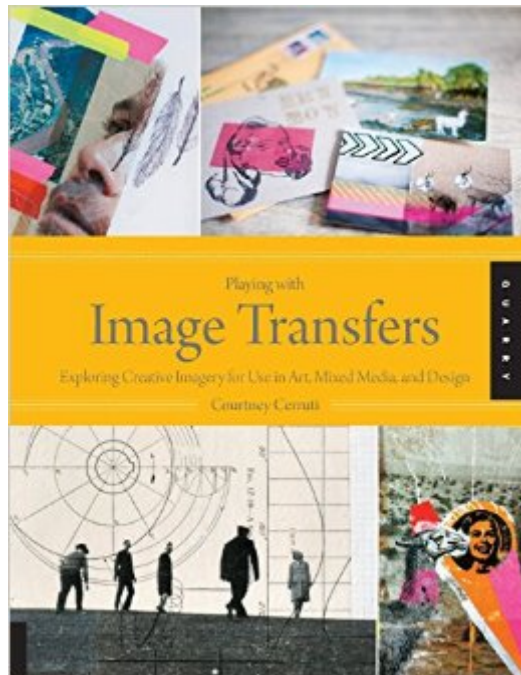

This book provides clear, concise steps for creating image transfers and gives tips on how to make art using newspapers, magazines or your own laser printouts.
