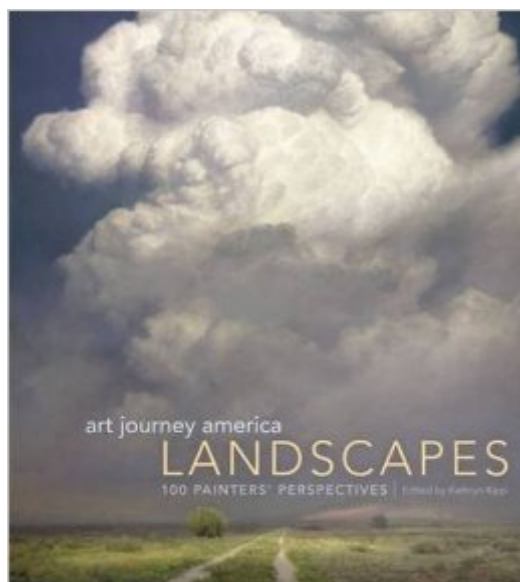

I highly recommend this book for anyone who loves beautiful art. The collection is varied and the questions that were asked of the artists help give insight into their work. As an artist myself, I appreciated the artist interviews and the beautiful reproductions of their work.

I purchased it because one of my instructors was in it as one of the landscape painters. The book came and it is beautiful. I leave it out for friends to look over when they come over. I find it interesting what each of the artists has to say about their process. It's a very interesting read and I would recommend it on many levels.

The reproductions are large and of high quality, the choice of paintings is not too bad, and there are plenty of them. But the interviews are irritating: Repeatedly artists are asked if their painting is

inspired by "spirituality." I love the way one painter handled the question, "My interest is in physics..."Landscape paintings are usually depictions of the natural world, and I wonder why the artists weren't _also_ asked how their paintings relate to ecology, science, or naturalism.Or, perhaps, Ms. Kipp should have just stuck to her less biased "What inspired this painting?" -- and let the artists' answers fall where they may.

I guess there's no winning with a book like this. About 10% of the illustrations /text impressed me, the rest didn't. Color reproduction is first rate, text is a bit mindless. OK at sale prices.

I'll say first that I think that the art collected here is interesting and varied. Many of the paintings seem to be technically superior. I say "seem" to be, because the images in the Kindle version of this publication had their file size reduced, I suppose for faster download. Thus, every time I saw an image that I wanted to look at, the moment I zoomed in, it would pixilate, rendering any detail impossible to see. As an artist, being unable to see a work well in beyond frustrating. The original images in the text are tiny, even on my iPad. I'm sure they are large and lovely in the print edition. I've returned the electronic edition, and will purchase the book.
